#### Requirements

- 1-8 years old
- Spayed or neutered
- Weigh at least 10 lbs
- Indoor only
- Good disposition
- Healthy
- Taking no medication (other than flea/tick/heartworm prevention)
- Current on vaccines
- Never had a blood transfusion
- Not traveled outside of New England

#### Benefits

- Free veterinary examination with each donation\*
- Free bag of Hill's food with each donation
- \$40 Tufts VETS credit with each donation
- Free blood transfusion in the event one is ever needed
- Free blood screening each year\*

#### Requirements

- 1-8 years old

- Good disposition
- Healthy
- Taking no medication (other than flea/tick/heartworm prevention)
- Current on vaccines
- Never had a blood transfusion
- Not traveled outside of New England
